Guidelines and Rules for Snow Tubes

1. You are responsible for your Snow Tube. If the tube or cover is damaged in any way, you will be financially responsible for the repairs.
2. If you damage or loose your tube, the following charges will apply:
Snow Tube with cover - \$100
Tube w/o cover - \$35.00
3. Tube in designated areas only (see map). These areas have been specifically prepared for tubing. Other areas can be full of hazards that can damage you or your tube.
4. If you are seen tubing in non designated areas, you will forfeit your deposit.
5. DO NOT walk in designated tubing areas. This destroys the snow pack and can cause collision injuries. When tube stops, exit parallel to the tube run area and walk back up on the perimeter (outside) of the tubing area.
6. Tubing can be a dangerous activity. Please follow these safety rules:
 - Only one person on a tube
 - No dragging or pulling tubes with motorized vehicles
 - Do not tube across mud, rocks, etc. If your tube area is showing mud, tubing must be stopped in this area.
 - Gloves must be worn for hand protection
 - Sit in tubes only - no face down (or belly) tubing. We have had serious facial injuries due to this type of tubing.
